On October 20, 2025, Hinton residents voted on their preferred recreation centre modernization options. The results were as follows.

48% voted in favour of
Option 1: Maintain

53% voted in favour of
Option 2: Expand

60% voted in favour of
Option 3: Build New

Budget 2026

In November and December, Council will discuss and approve the Town of Hinton's 2026 budget. It includes two parts: **Operating** and **Capital**. The **Operating Budget** is for programs and services. The **Capital Budget** is for infrastructure, such as water pipes, snow plows, fire trucks, roads, and buildings. Council will decide which projects to fund, and a public report will be available in January 2026 summarizing those decisions.
