


Budget 2026 Discussions

Council is currently discussing the Town of Hinton's 2026 budget, and deciding which projects to fund. A budget must be approved by December 31, 2025.

The budget has two parts: Operating and Capital. The **Operating Budget** pays for programs and services. The **Capital Budget** pays for infrastructure such as water pipes, snow plows, fire trucks, roads, and buildings. A report will be available in January 2026 summarizing Budget 2026.

As of January 1, 2025, paper invoices cost \$2 per bill. **Sign up for electronic billing** to avoid this charge. Just provide your account number and email address.


